



WINTER ECLECTIC / MEDAL RULES

Competition Trophies

The Herbert Booth Trophy will be awarded to the player who has the best combined scratch score over Winter Eclectic 1 and 2.

The W S Strachan Trophy will be awarded to the player who has the best combined net score over Winter Eclectic' 1 and 2.

Competition dates

The first half of the Eclectic competition will run from Saturday 5th November 2016 to Friday 30th December 2016.

The second half of the Eclectic competition will run from Saturday 7th January 2017 to Friday 24th March 2017.

Qualifying days

Members should note that only their 1st card in any week will count towards the eclectic and the eclectic week will run from Saturdays to Fridays.

Players choosing to play Monday – Friday and Sunday: -

- Sign in on computer, the entry fee of £1.00 (not refundable - please ensure you can play)
- Place cards in the Card Box. All cards must be returned.

Players choosing to play on Saturdays: -

- Sign in on computer, the entry fee of £1.00 (not refundable - please ensure you can play)
- Place completed cards in the Card Box. All cards must be returned.
- A sweep will be played alongside the eclectic competition, (Saturday only), entry fee £1.00 (Optional)
- Monthly medal competitions will also be played - on one designated Saturday of each month.

On Saturdays, only: -

- Monthly Medals will only be played if winter greens are not in use. If a winter green is in use on the planned day of a winter medal, it will be held on the next Saturday available with normal greens in play.

Please Note:

Members are reminded that they MUST enter the "Comp." element of any eclectic competition week as they cannot enter by way of sweep only. Should any member enter the sweep only during the eclectic week their entry will be transferred to the competition entry. It is only the sweep that is optional and not the competition.

Course closures

Weather conditions will determine whether Winter Greens and Tees are in operation. All scores whether on Full or Winter Greens and / or Full or Winter Tees will count towards your Eclectic score.

Handicaps

The Competition System will allocate all players with a 'Winter Handicap', which will commence with their final Summer season handicap as at 31st October. The Competition System will revert to the Summer Season handicap on completion of the Winter Eclectic programme. The Handicap allowance for the winter eclectic and medals will be $\frac{3}{4}$ of the full winter handicap.

All Winter Eclectic and Monthly Medal scores will be published on How-did-I-do.

Sections and prizes

- Eclectic and Sweep handicap sections will be up to 10 and 11 to 28.
- Eclectic competition entry fees will fund vouchers for the section winners.
- Sweep monies will be divided amongst Saturday section sweep winners.
